Tama-Do (*Way of the Soul*) Academy, created in 1988 by Fabien Maman, the founding father of vibrational sound therapy (Websters' Dictionary), is dedicated to the evolution of human consciousness through research, teachings and creativity. We offer courses in non-invasive techniques using Sound, Color and Movement® and Harmonizing Concerts® to ground the Soul in daily life.

Once a year we offer all of Tama-Do Academy's Level I Practitioner Training Program in a 2-week Intensive Training in Europe. (This intensive is 3 weeks of work compressed into 2 weeks! It's the best way to immerse yourself in the work!) No previous experience necessary. Everyone is welcome!

This year our Home will be in a retreat center nestled near a lush pine forest at the foot of the Swiss Alps, 3000' high, overlooking Lac de Neuchatel. The energetic quality of this space offers tranquility and vibrancy, mystery and magic. Switzerland is the land of the Devas of Nature, the elves and fairies of the mountains and forests, cascades and sky. Neuchatel was a passageway for the legendary Druid caravans, making their way to the South of France. This place offers opportunities for your own inner pathways to be revealed.

This Level I Summer Intensive, taught by Senior Instructor Terres Unsoeld includes all 9 of the Level I courses:

Kototama	(Harmonizing the Aura with musical instruments around the body)
T.E.P.	(Touch technique with sound and color)
Musical Spine	(Tuning Forks and Color on the Bladder Meridian)
Shu Points	(Tuning Forks on Acupuncture Command Points and Diagnosis)
Psychology of Chinese Temperaments	
Self Healing with Color	(Accessing your Soul Color)
Color Healing and Diagnosis	(With Tama-Do Rainbow Etheric Essences, Color Silks and Lights)
Tao Yin Fa Series I & II	(Movement for Health)
8 Qi Mo	(Tuning Forks on the Extraordinary Meridians)

Each technique, grounded in the classical traditions of music, mathematics, astrology and Chinese medicine, has been researched and developed by Fabien Maman over a course of 30 years.

Level I is taught simultaneously with Level II, which will be taught by Fabien Maman. Mornings and evenings will combine both groups in special activities. Mornings will begin with Tao Yin Fa together, a form of Qi Gong created by Fabien Maman. Evening gatherings include sacred chanting, over toning and meditation. The course will end with a Seasonal Harmonizing Concert. All activities will reflect the unique spiritual/energetic perspective of Tama-Do.

Tama-Do's Level I Intensive creates the opportunity to reach far beyond tuning fork techniques. We offer the practice of giving, receiving and sharing as Human Beings. We ask that each student respect and join a sacred circle created by the group, so that the finer vibrations of wonder and joy may flourish. These teachings have been developed for more than 30 years with love and care. We practice respect for the teachings, the teachers and the group. All expectation and previous modalities are left at the door so that we may enter with open hearts and open mind. The Way of the Soul ~ it's a beautiful journey....

Schedule your trip:

We recommend you arrive a couple days early to get over jet lag and enjoy Switzerland! We suggest that you come directly to our center in Neuchatel. We will be there 3 days in advance, working with the Level II Practitioner Candidates. They'll need bodies to practice on for their final test! They will be happy to see you!

June 28-30: Arrive anytime and get worked on by Level II Practitioner Candidates! (food and lodging for these days is extra)

Wednesday July 1: Official arrival and check-in by 4pm

July 2-14: Workshop

Wednesday, July 15: Leave after breakfast.

Schedule flights home: Give yourself 1 hour to take a taxi from the center to Neuchatel train station, and another 2 hours to take a train from Neuchatel to Geneva (if you don't miss your connection). Then 2 hours for security at the airport...

Accommodations:

This course is residential and takes place in a magnificent setting overlooking the Lake of Neuchatel, surrounded by the Swiss Alps. Hiking and exploration is available minutes away from the center. The Swiss are famous for their excellent hospitality and farm fresh foods. Private rooms are available upon request.

How to get there:

From the United States, fly to Geneva, Switzerland, and take a train to Neuchatel. (the train station is easily situated in the airport). From Neuchatel, you will take a taxi to the center. You will be given directions when you register.

What to bring:

A set of loose white clothes for the Tao Yin Fa in the morning (7am) and meditation in the evenings*good walking shoes*sweaters and/or jackets for the evenings*battery alarm clock*little flashlight*Rain gear (the weather is unpredictable)* if you insist on bringing a hairdryer make sure you have the appropriate electrical converters for Switzerland

Registration:

All fees include tuition for all 9 Level I courses, food, and lodging and workbook.

(Not included: transport to Switzerland and to and from the Retreat Center)

\$3500 (double room in center, fees and food)

Private room supplement: \$1000.

Limited spaces available. \$700 non refundable deposit due by February 15. Reservations are not firm until full payment is received. Due to high season summer traffic, you will want to take your ticket as soon as possible for the best fares.
