Tama-Do (*Way of the Soul*) Academy, created in 1988 by Fabien Maman, the founding father of vibrational sound therapy (Websters' Dictionary), is dedicated to the evolution of human consciousness through research, teachings and creativity. We offer courses in non-invasive techniques using Sound, Color and Movement® and Harmonizing Concerts® to ground the Soul in daily life.

Once a year we offer all of Tama-Do Academy's Level I Practitioner Training Program in a 2-week Intensive Training in Europe. (This intensive is 3 weeks of work compressed into 2 weeks! It's the best way to immerse yourself in the work!) No previous experience necessary. Everyone is welcome!

This year our Home will be in a retreat center nestled in a national preserve on Tenerife, Spain (one of the 7 Canary Islands off the coast of Morocco), overlooking the Atlantic Ocean. With direct access to the beach, this place has a special peace and energy surrounded by lush tropical vegetation, sunshine and butterflies! with magnificent views of the azure coastline and the commanding Mount Teide, Spain's highest mountain (13,000'). This place is considered heaven on earth!

This Level I Summer Intensive, taught by Senior Instructor Terres Unsoeld includes all 9 of the Level I courses:

Kototama: The Ancient Science of Pure Sound	(12 CE hours)
T.E.P. (Tama-Do Extra Points)	(12 CE hours)
Tuning Forks on the Musical Spine	(12 CE hours)
Tuning Forks on Acupuncture Command Points (Shu Points) and Assessment)	(18 CE hours)
Psychology of Chinese Temperaments	(6 CE hours)
Color Glasses	(12 CE hours)
Color for Practitioners	(18 CE hours)
Tao Yin Fa Series I & II (Qi Gong for Health and Vitality)	(12 CE hours)
Tuning Forks on the Subtle Body Command Points (8 Qi Mo)	(18 CE hours)

Each technique, grounded in the classical traditions of music, mathematics, astrology and Chinese medicine, has been researched and developed by Fabien Maman over a course of 30 years.

Level I is taught simultaneously with Level II, which will be taught by Fabien Maman. Mornings and evenings will combine both groups in special activities. Mornings will begin with Tao Yin Fa together, a form of Qi Gong created by Fabien Maman. Evening gatherings include sacred chanting, over toning and meditation. The course will end with a Seasonal Harmonizing Concert. All activities will reflect the unique spiritual/energetic perspective of Tama-Do.

Tama-Do's Level I Intensive creates the opportunity to reach far beyond tuning fork techniques. We offer the practice of giving, receiving and sharing as Human Beings. We ask that each student respect and join a sacred circle created by the group, so that the finer vibrations of wonder and joy may flourish. These teachings have been developed for more than 30 years with love and care. We practice respect for the teachings, the teachers and the group. All expectation and previous modalities are left at the door so that we may enter with open hearts and open mind. The Way of the Soul ~ it's a beautiful journey....

Schedule your trip:

We recommend you arrive a couple days early to get over jet lag and enjoy the sites and sun of Tenerife! We suggest that you come directly to the retreat Center on the North of the island. We will be there 3 days in advance, working with the Level II Practitioner Candidates. They'll need bodies to practice on for their final test! They will be happy to work on you!

June 13-16: Arrive anytime and get worked on by Level II Practitioner Candidates! (food and lodging for these days is \$100 extra per day)

Wednesday June 16: Official arrival and check-in by 4pm

June 17-30: Workshop

Wednesday, June 30: Leave after breakfast.

Schedule flights home: Give yourself 2 hour to take a bus from the Center back to Tenerife South. Then 2 hours for security at the airport...

Accommodations:

This course is residential and takes place in a magnificent tropical island setting in the Atlantic Ocean off the southern coast of Morocco. Hiking and exploration, swimming and the beach are all available within a 10 minute drive. The Center itself is 200m above the sea with an extraordinary 4000m2 garden. This liberating and spacious area opens our senses and our hearts in a completely natural way and radiates a special depth and inspiration. We feel what it is to be at one with our inner nature and our resources, Private rooms are available upon request.

How to get there:

From the United States, fly to Tenerife South. (there are 2 airports on the island. Check both out for prices. We are told it is cheaper to fly to Tenerife South (there are good deals via the UK) and then rent a car and drive to the center on the North part of the island. Car rentals are about \$300/week. This gives you daily access to the beach and the surrounding nature reserves. If you don't want to rent a car, a bus can be arranged for pick-up. We will give more precise information when you register.

What to bring:

A set of loose white clothes for the Tao Yin Fa in the morning (7am) and meditation in the evenings*good walking shoes*bathing suit* sweaters and/or jackets for the evenings*battery alarm clock*little flashlight* if you insist on bringing a hairdryer make sure you have the appropriate electrical converters for Spain

Registration:

All fees include tuition for all 9 Level I courses, food, and lodging and workbook.

(Not included: transport to Tenerife and to and from the Retreat Center)

\$3500 (double room in center, fees and food)

Private room supplement: \$1500.

Limited spaces available. \$700 non refundable deposit due by February 15. Reservations are not firm until full payment is received. Due to high season summer traffic, you will want to take your ticket as soon as possible for the best fares.

Full fees due by April 15.

Cancellations: Before 12 weeks prior to the start date: Full refund minus the deposit; 12 weeks or less from start date: No Refunds.
