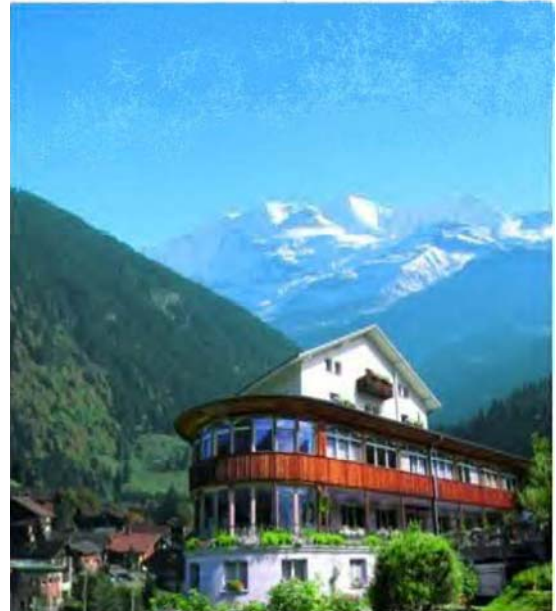

Tama-Do (*Way of the Soul*) Academy, created in 1988 by Fabien Maman, the founding father of vibrational sound therapy (Websters' Dictionary), is dedicated to the evolution of human consciousness through research, teachings and creativity. We offer courses in non-invasive techniques using Sound, Color and Movement® and Harmonizing Concerts® to ground the Soul in daily life.



Once a year we offer all of Tama-Do Academy's Level I Practitioner Training Program in a 2-week Intensive Training in Europe. (This intensive is 3 weeks of work compressed into 2 weeks! It's the best way to immerse yourself in the work! Experience in energy work is important.)

This year our home will be in Kiental, a charming Swiss village surrounded by mountains (the Bluemlisalp ~3663 meters), deep forests, rushing waterfalls, green grass, wildlife and incredible skies! This is Nature at its best, offering purity, tranquility, vibrancy and adventure for those who seek re-sourcing and renewal along their way.

This Level I Summer Intensive, taught by Senior Instructor Terres Unsoeld includes all 9 of the Level I courses:

- Kototama** (Harmonizing the Aura with musical instruments around the body)
- T.E.P.** (Touch technique with sound and color)
- Musical Spine** (Tuning Forks and Color down the spine)
- Shu Points** (Tuning Forks on Acupuncture Command Points and Assessment)
- Psychology of Chinese Temperaments**
- Color I** (Accessing the Way of the Soul through Color)
- Color II** (With Tama-Do Faery Essentials®, Color Silks and Lights)
- Tao Yin Fa Series I & II** (Movement for Health)
- 8 Qi Mo** (Tuning Forks on the 8 Extraordinary Meridians)

Each technique, grounded in the classical traditions of music, mathematics, astrology and Chinese medicine, has been researched and developed by Fabien Maman over a course of 30 years.

Level I is taught simultaneously with Level II, which will be taught by Fabien Maman. Mornings and evenings will combine both groups in special activities. Mornings will begin with Tao Yin Fa together, a form of Qi Gong created by Fabien Maman. Evening gatherings include sacred chanting, over toning and meditation. The course will end with a Seasonal Harmonizing Concert. All activities will reflect the unique spiritual/energetic perspective of Tama-Do.

Tama-Do's Level I Intensive creates the opportunity to reach far beyond tuning fork techniques. We offer the practice of giving, receiving and sharing as Human Beings. We ask that each student respect and join a sacred circle created by the group, so that the finer vibrations of wonder and joy may flourish. These teachings have been developed for more than 30 years with love and care. We practice respect for the teachings, the teachers and the group. All expectation and previous modalities are left at the door so that we may enter with open hearts and open mind. The Way of the Soul ~ it's a beautiful journey....

### **Schedule your trip:**

We recommend you arrive a couple days early to get over jet lag and enjoy the sites and sun around the Bernese Oberland area and Lake Thun. Ask about our list of lodging options.

**Sunday June 17:** Official arrival and check-in by 4pm

**June 18-June 30:** Workshop

**Sunday, July 1:** Leave after breakfast.

**Schedule flights home:** Give yourself 4 hours to travel by train from the Center back to Geneva. Then 2 hours for security at the airport...

### **Accommodations:**

The center is more than hundred years old. It has been carefully renovated with beautiful lecture halls and lounges in joyful colors and ecological materials. The energy is fantastic, encouraging personal growth, community and creativity. The sleeping rooms are big and bright with beautiful views and, for the most part, private bathrooms. The kitchen prepares balanced and richly varied meals which are mostly vegetarian. We will request supplemental chicken, fish and eggs to fulfill our protein needs. Private rooms are limited and must be paid for in full to reserve.

### **How to get there:**

Kiental, meaning "the valley of pines and rolling rocks", is a small village near Spiez, at the border of the beautiful lake of Thun. It is best to fly into Geneva or Zurich. From the airport it is easy to catch a train to Spiez. (give yourself 4 hours to arrive) (Website to buy train tkts: [www.sbb.ch](http://www.sbb.ch))

From Spiez you can take the local train to Reichenbach (direction Kandersteg) and there you can change to a Postbus to Kiental. The Bus stops just in front of the Kientalerhof (station Post). Taxis can be arranged at Spiez or Reichenbach. From Spiez a taxi takes only 20 minutes to reach Kiental.

### **What to bring:**

A set of loose white clothes for the Tao Yin Fa in the morning (7am) and meditation in the evenings\*good walking shoes\*bathing suit\*sweaters and/or jackets for the evenings\*battery alarm clock\*little flashlight\* if you insist on bringing a hairdryer make sure you have the appropriate electrical converters for Switzerland!

### **Registration:**

All fees include tuition for all 9 Level I courses, food, lodging. (Not included: Tama-Do tools and transport to and from the Retreat Center)

### **Early Bird Registration:**

**\$3600 if paid in full by Dec. 31, 2011**

### **Regular Registration:**

**\$4000** (double room, tuition, food)
